DISCUSS

When have you felt the temptation to "settle" in your faith?

What obstacles keep us from continual transformation as disciples?

How would you define the myth of “spiritual arrival” in your own words?

TAKEAWAY

Identify one area where you sense God challenging you to grow or change.

What step could you take to pursue ongoing transformation this week?

In what ways can you start to think multiplication in your walk with Jesus this week?

BIG IDEA *Equipped people multiply impact.*

EXPLORE

What is Jesus teaching in the Parable of the Sower?

How does 2 Timothy 2:2 illustrate the principle of multiplication in discipleship?

Which type of “soil” do you most relate to right now?

DISCUSS

What does it practically look like to “equip others” and make space for their growth?

Why is grace important as we seek to multiply leaders and disciples?

What are ways our group can become better multipliers?

TAKEAWAY

Who is someone you can intentionally invest in or “equip” this week?

What does it mean to “replace yourself” in ministry or community service?

Where do you need to “make more space” or “give more grace” in your life?

PRAYER

FATHER, GIVE US HEARTS THAT DESIRE 100X FRUIT. SHOW US OPPORTUNITIES TO EQUIP OTHERS FOR YOUR KINGDOM AND GIVE US COURAGE TO STEP ASIDE SO OTHERS CAN RISE.

EXPLORE

What risks and rewards are highlighted in the Parable of the Talents?

How do Jesus' final instructions in Matthew 28 and Acts 1 broaden our view of multiplication?

What did the servants' actions reveal about trust and responsibility?

DISCUSS

What risks have you taken, or could you take, for the mission of God?

How can we keep the "big picture" in mind when serving our church and the world?

Why is it important not to multiply “just for us” but for God’s greater Kingdom?

TAKEAWAY

What’s one faith risk you sense God leading you to take this month?

How can you support the “global church” mission, even if your impact feels small?

Where do you see opportunities to multiply “outside” your usual circles?

DISCUSS

What is the difference between a one-time gift and a giving lifestyle?

How does practicing “first and best” generosity shape our faith community?

What challenges or motivates you to live generously?

TAKEAWAY

What is one area where you can offer God your “first and best” this week?

How will you keep generosity a priority beyond this series?
